What is a call sign?



TEACHER GUIDELINES

STARBASE CODE OF CONDUCT

While at STARBASE if a student exhibits inappropriate, disruptive or unsafe behavior the following STARBASE Code of Conduct guidelines will be initiated:

1st Infraction: An adult will give a verbal warning.

2nd Infraction: The student will be removed from the activity and a private discussion with an adult

will occur before the student returns to the class. The student will also be shown

the Code of Conduct guidelines.

3rd Infraction: The student will be given a supervised time-out where he/she will come up with a

written agreement with the STARBASE Team that will help him/her to be a more

productive part of the class.

4th Infraction: The student's parent/caregiver will be called to take him/her home or the teacher

will arrange for transportation back to the school.

The student may be invited back the next day. However, if the same pattern continues to occur, the student will be asked to leave and will not be invited back.
